



## Seeking Females for Control Study

### What

- A research study to assess the risks of short and long-term use of Nuvaring in comparison to oral contraceptives.

### Why

- Though Nuvaring may have some non-contraceptive health benefits (e.g., better cycle control or better compliance), it is primarily used by healthy women and even small changes of the incidence or rare adverse drug reactions may have an unfavorable or favorable impact on the risk/benefit equation of Nuvaring.

### Who

- English speaking females of all races, aged 18 years or older.
- Women who were just prescribed Nuvaring OR oral contraceptives on that visit.
- Women switching from one pill to another or switching to Nuvaring on that visit.
- A woman restarting Nuvaring or a pill prescription on that visit. She should be off Nuvaring or the prescription for at least one month.

### Pay

- Participants will be paid for their study time and effort.

### Details

- Patient is to fill out the Enrollment Packet (takes approximately 10 minutes). In the future, TASC study staff will contact patients up to two times a year for three years to fill out a one page questionnaire.
